

Regular Household Waste & Bulky Items known as Garbage

(limited to contents of carts)

Pick-up is Every Wednesday for the Entire Village

Rates are \$17.50 per month beginning May 1, 2023.

- Containers may not be placed curb side before 6:00 PM. the evening before pickup and MUST be removed by 6:00 PM the evening of pickup.
- All trash and recyclables must be at the curb by 5:00 AM.
- All trash must be placed in a cart.
- Please call Northern Illinois Disposal 800-930-7321 to rent additional carts for \$36 annually with a \$36 delivery fee.
- Includes pickup of two bulk waste items – which include couches, chairs, mattresses, tables, dressers, bicycles, rugs,
- carpets (30 lbs., 4 feet long max.), etc.

Trash, Recycling & Yard Waste Guidelines

Village Of Mt. Morris Recycling Guidelines

Recycling pick-up is every Wednesday for the Village.

(Items may be mixed together in one container)

Metal Products

Tin & aluminum cans only. Be sure all items are empty. Place lids inside of cans.

Glass Products

Glass jars & bottles only. Be sure all items are empty and remove lids. Labels need not be removed. *(Window glass is considered household waste)*

Plastic Products

Plastic jugs and bottles and containers with the numbers 1 through 7 on the bottom are acceptable. Empty containers & remove lids. Labels need not be removed.

Paper Products

All newsprint, cardboard and heavy wrapping paper is acceptable. Please stack neatly in your recycling bin or a paper grocery bag. Boxes break down and fold into bin. In the event that you have more recyclables than your bin will hold all items may be placed in separate paper bags or container near your recycling bin. **Please do not use large garbage bags for your excess recyclable items.**

The Village of Mt Morris will continue to collect leaves in the fall only. All leaves will be placed at the curb for access by the vacuum truck. Exact dates of leaf pick-up service will be announced each year as fall conditions are known.

Yard Waste Pick-up By Contractor

(Unlimited Quantity)

Every Wednesday from

April 1st - 3rd Week of Nov.

Yard waste should be at the curb by 5:00 AM.

- Yard waste should be placed in a container marked with an X, not exceeding 33 gallons in capacity and/or 30 pounds.
- Biodegradable yard waste bags or cardboard boxes are acceptable and **Will Not** be emptied or left on site. **Plastic garbage bags are NOT acceptable.**
- Branches not exceeding 1" in diameter or 4' in length are acceptable.
- Unbundled or yard waste will be rejected at the curb.
- Special bags can be purchased at the Village Clerk's office.

Brush Pick-up By Mt Morris Street Dept.

Brush larger than 1" and after major storms will be picked up every Monday of the month, Mar - 3rd Week of Nov

- Brush larger than 1" diameter (Branch less than a 1" are considered yard waste.)
- Place brush on the terrace by 7:00 AM on the pick-up day parallel and close to the curb, but not in the street.
- Brush piles are not to exceed 4' in height, 4' in depth and 12' in length with 1' spacing between piles.
- Do not pile brush under low hanging trees, behind or around utility poles, trees or other obstructions, or on top of water valves. The city will not be held responsible for damage caused to water lines due to piling brush on top.
- Piles not considered yard waste or not stacked properly will not be picked up.

Items Not Included In Household Pick-up

Construction Materials

Construction items include remodeling waste, doors, windows, drywall, wood scraps, blocks, bricks, rock, sand, dirt, landscape timbers, old auto parts, etc.

Residents must arrange for pickup of these items privately. Large dumpsters are available for construction projects.

White Goods

White goods include stoves, refrigerators, water heaters, freezers, softener tanks, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, washers, dryers, etc. **Residents must arrange for pick-up of these items privately.** Residents with household hazardous waste should look or county sponsored programs which are held periodically.

Electronics

As of January 1, 2012, The Electronic Products Recycling and Reuse Public Act 97-287 prohibits the disposal of e-waste into landfills. The following items will no longer be picked up per this law: **Computers, Video Game Console, Computer Monitors, Electronic Mice, Printers, Scanners, Televisions, Digital Converter Boxes, Electronic Keyboards, Cable Receivers, Fax Machines, Satellite Receivers, Videocassette Recorders, Digital Video Disc (DVD) Machines, Portable Digital Music Players, Small Scale Servers.**
